Bartłomiej Blesznowski is a historian of ideas and sociologist of knowledge, and a researcher in the Institute of Applied Social Sciences at the University of Warsaw. In his work, he deals with issues of power and politics in contemporary society, combining social science with philosophy. He is the author of a monograph on Michel Foucault (*Batalia o człowieka. Genealogia władzy Michela Foucaulta jako próba wyzwolenia podmiotu*, 2009) and is editor of the Polish edition of his late writings (Michel Foucault, *Kim Pan jest, Profesorze Foucault? Debaty, rozmowy, polemiki*, 2013). He has edited a volume on Polish cooperative traditions (*Kooperatyzm, spółdzielczość, demokracja*, 2014) and coedited, with Marcin Król, a series of books on the history of Polish ideas (*Genealogia współczesności. Historia idei w Polsce 1815–1939*, 2013–2015).

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
